- only upload the photos they have taken on a dedicated folder “RING Meeting photos” created for the event, and with a password restricted access,
- delete the photos they have taken from their smartphone once they have uploaded them on the above mentioned folder.

These signed confidentiality forms will be available for consultation by the participants upon request.
